ARTICLE VII SWIMMING POOL RULES

The operation of the swimming pool is under the direction of the pool manager. The pool manager is responsible for the enforcement of discipline necessary for the safe conduct of operation within the confines of the pool area. In and around the pool, safety comes first, and the rules and regulations are set accordingly. The pool manager has the authority to suspend anyone for the day, or a longer period, for violations of rules.

SECTION 1.

All members and guests must sign the register before entering the pool area. Guest fees are charged on a per person basis at the published rates for guests of members. Members are not charged guest fees for baby sitters. Members are not charged guest fees for their grandchildren under the age of 16 years, but they (grandparents) must accompany their grandchildren in the pool area. A temporary guest pool pass may be requested from the general manager for out-of-town guests staying in a memberøs home for an extended period of time. A non-member may be a guest at the pool a maximum of 12 times a year.

SECTION 2.

The pool will open on Memorial Day weekend and close after Labor Day weekend.

SECTION 3.

Lifeguards are provided by the Club for the protection of members and their guests. Absolutely no one is allowed to swim after 8 p.m.

SECTION 4.

The wading pool & splash park is reserved for small children who cannot stand in the large pool. The wading pool is not staffed by a lifeguard, and the parents or guardians of children using the wading pool shall assume full responsibility for the safety of their children.

SECTION 5.

Children under seven years of age are not allowed in the pool or within the confines of the pool area unless accompanied by an adult at all times. Children with water wings must swim with an adult.

SECTION 6.

Glass is hazardous in pool areas and is not allowed. Suntan lotion and other containers must be plastic. Food and beverages are limited to designated pool areas. No food or beverage may be brought to the Club from outside sources. Chewing gum is not permitted in the pool area.

SECTION 7.

State law requires all swimmers to take showers before entering the pool.

SECTION 8.

All persons making use of the pool do so at their own risk, and the Club assumes no responsibility for injury or damage resulting from such use.

SECTION 9.

Personal property is the responsibility of the member or guest, and the Club is not responsible for any loss of, damage to, or theft of such personal property.

SECTION 10.

- No running is allowed on the pool deck.
- Hanging on the ropes or playing on the ladders is not permitted.
- Diving in the shallow end is not permitted.

- Toys, rafts, and floats are allowed. Members should check with the pool manager on duty before taking such objects to the large pool or the area surrounding the large pool.
- Inappropriate language will not be tolerated.
- Disorderly conduct and abuse of the locker room facility will not be tolerated. The locker rooms are to be used for showering and the changing of clothes. The changing of diapers must always be done in the locker rooms and NOT poolside. Thoughtfulness in the care of this facility is imperative. Any abuse of the facility should be reported immediately to the lifeguard on duty.
- Swimmers must stay in the pool area and are not permitted on the golf course, tennis courts, driving range, putting green, or in the clubhouse in swim attire.
- All bicycles must be parked in the bike rack.
- The fence around the pool area is not to be climbed on or used as a rack for towels or bags. The fence is for pool security only.

SECTION 11.

The pool may close at any time at the discretion of management due to unfavorable weather.

ARTICLE VIII SWIMMING POOL HOURS OF OPERATION

SECTION 1.

The hours of operation of the swimming pool shall be as follows, subject to changes made necessary because of weather conditions, swim meets, and set-up for large poolside functions.

Memorial Day Weekend to Labor Day Weekend Monday - Friday 12 p.m. 68 p.m. Saturday, Sunday and Holidays 11 a.m. - 9 p.m.
